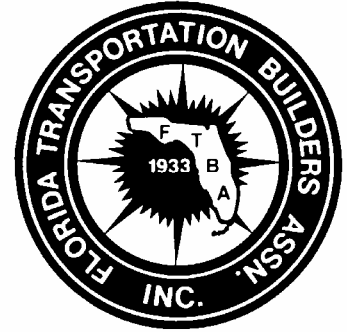

### **“Advanced” Course** \$350.00 Per Person

*Florida “Advanced” training involves 20-hours of comprehensive training on the Florida Roadway and Traffic Design Standards (FRTDS), The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Florida plans Preparation Manual (FPPM), Florida’s Construction Project Administration Manual (FCPAM), and Florida’s Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction (FSSRBC). Classroom instruction in traffic control devices, minimum design standards, design work of rural multi-lane, urban multi-lane, Interstate, high volume multi-access, urban multi-lane and traffic control plan exercises that include the design of an MOT traffic plan (that requires special treatment not covered in the MUTCD or FSSRBC) that contain dysfunctional elements. Students will participate in design exercises and problem solving of MOT traffic control plans. A written test is required and students will receive a certificate of completion and a wallet size card.*
